

KEEP SAFE INFORMATION



	<p>KEEP SAFE aims to help disabled people feel safe in their community.</p> <p>It also aims to raise awareness of disability hate crime and encourage people to report this.</p>
	<p>KEEP SAFE works with local shops and public buildings to create safe places for people to go if they are lost, scared, need help or have had a crime committed against them.</p>
	<p>The shops and other buildings will put a KEEP SAFE sticker in their window where it can easily be seen.</p>
	<p>You can have a KEEP SAFE card, which holds information about your health, how you communicate, and the contact details of people who will support you if you need this.</p>
	<p>If you need help, you can go into a shop or building where you see the KEEP SAFE logo. Staff will help you</p>
	<p>They can help to contact the person you want to come and support you. They can give you directions to where you want to go.</p>
	<p>They can phone the police for you if you need them to.</p> <p>101 (non emergency) 999 (emergency)</p>
